*Julie's Holy Family Village in Haiti*

*In the aftermath of the tragic January 12<sup>th</sup> earthquake in Haiti, Tricoci University, our students and our associates all mobilized to raise funds to support Julie's Holy Family Village in Thomazeau, Haiti, which is trying to rebuild from the devastation.*

*Julie's Holy Family Village was established in 2009 in memory of Julie Sokulski Hesser by Julie's parents, and provides basic services and infrastructure for Haitian children and their families in what was formerly a destitute part of Haiti.*

*"The residents of Julie's Holy Family Village used to live in horrifyingly desperate conditions," said Robin Mahfood, President/CEO of Food For The Poor, a partner in the project. "We have seen a remarkable difference in the faces of the children, and the overall health of the village. Every child should be given a chance at life, and that is what Julie's Holy Family Village provides."*
