Fall & Winter Trending

Clients look to you for suggestions on all things beauty; as a professional, you should always be armed with suggestions on how to keep clients on trend. **Jen McGann**, Director of Cosmetology at Tricoci University of Beauty Culture, predicts this year's fall and winter hair trends will have an organic quality—thanks to natural, loose and effortless-looking texture. Here are McGann's stand-out trends:

The Loose Knot

The Loose Knot: Twist hair into a loose bun, and secure with bobby pins. Keep the knot low at the nape and leave some front pieces hanging out to create a chic, yet laid-back vibe. Add a touch of hairspray to complete.

Waved Bob: This shoulder-length cut is very versatile, and when you add tousled curls, it creates a very romantic feel. Add volumizing mousse to damp hair for body and allow hair to air dry. Touch up the waves with a curling iron, but still keep the relaxed and understated look.

Full Fringe: Fall is the perfect time for clients to try bangs. The summer months are hot and humid and cause fringes to be unruly and act out. Blunt bangs are hot right now, but make sure you don't cut them too thick. Clients can also sweep fringe to the side to change their look.

Long & Natural: Long waves were seen all over fall runways and work well with any hair texture. Part hair in the center and curl hair with a 1-inch barrel iron, leaving out the ends so it looks a little undone. Once cooled, shake out the curls and finger-comb to create soft waves.

Bombshell Color: All shades warm up during the fall and winter months, so remove obvious highlights and pick a color that matches closer to original. Red becomes deep and rich. Brunettes are warm. Blondes need to warm up with golden tones.
