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Tips For This Halloween!

80s ROCKER

HAIR TIPS:

"Gather yourself some torn up jeans, off the shoulder sweatshirts or tees, a netted skirt and plenty of hard hold hairspray. 80's looks are about too much makeup and too much hairspray.

Remember to tease your hair for that height in the front or place a high, side pony in for a serious retro effect. Get out your curling irons and tease away. Remember – the bigger, the better."

MAKEUP TIPS:

- The 80's are all about color, color and more color
- Use pastel colored shadows and apply a colorful rainbow to your upper lid
 - Apply lots of black liner and mascara
- Finish the look off with bright lipstick in fuchsia or red

Vampire

HAIR TIPS:

"Vamp it up this Halloween by thinking all things sleek. A vampire's hair is also well maintained, be sure to add a ton of shine to your hair whether you wear it up or down. If you're not sure what to do, get a wig! Wigs are a fun way to change up your look and become your favorite version of a vampire. Be sure to check out clothing and makeup choices to really complete this look."

MAKEUP TIPS:

Create sharp lines with your liner and angle it upwards and out to make the eyes very intense

- - Do the same technique with your eye shadow to take it up a level
 - Pick a darker shadow and follow the angle of the liner to create really dark, intense eyes
 - No vampire look is complete without dark lips, so choose a dark burgundy shade or even black
 - Finish it off with a little artificial blood at the corners of your mouth



Flapper

HAIR TIPS:

"To achieve a flapper look for your mane, it's all about creating simple waves or a straight fringed bob. Feel free to add a fun head piece! Use your curling iron to wave your hair, then comb it all out together and spray into place. This is also a fun look to get a wig for, it completely changes your look!"

MAKEUP TIPS:

- Smokey eye, take a black shadow and apply it with a sponge applicator or q-tip to avoid harsh lines
 - surround the entire eye with the shadow
 - apply bright blush to the apple of the cheeks
 - line your lips with a bright red lip liner
- To create the cupid's bow leave out the corners of your mouth (about 1/4 inch)
 - apply plenty of red lipstick and your flapper look is complete
